The Board of Supervisors of Calhoun County met with the following members present: Hoag, Sr., Jacobs, & Nicholson

Agenda additions: None

It was moved by Nicholson and seconded by Jacobs to approve the agenda. Ayes all. Motion carried.

The minutes of the last meeting were read. It was moved by Jacobs and seconded by Nicholson to approve the minutes. Ayes all. Motion carried.

It was moved by Jacobs and seconded by Nicholson to review the claims (checks) #29252 through #29381 and warrant #502220 and were allowed as endorsed. Ayes all. Motion carried.

It was moved by Nicholson and seconded by Jacobs to approve Application for Approval of Construction Across Established Calhoun County Drainage Districts for Windstream Communications, Inc. for placing 6 pair copper telephone cable from intersection of 370th Street south 260' south on Garber Ave. This does not cross any drainage districts. Ayes all. Motion carried.

It was moved by Nicholson and seconded by Jacobs to approve the Application for Use of Calhoun County Courthouse Grounds by the Rockwell City Chamber for Sweet Corn Daze, Saturday, August 4. Ayes all. Motion carried.

Cindy Voorde, David Gidel, and Ron Haden, Engineer, met with the Board concerning signs for the engine brake ordinance. Cindy will check into this further for placement of signs.

A telephonic call was received from the Webster County Board of Supervisors concerning drainage engineer's bills for the following joint drainage districts: Jt DD 70 Webster - 95 Calhoun to MHF Engineering to investigate total ditch cleanout at \$35,785 and JT DD 12 Webster - 38 Calhoun to MHF Engineering to investigate total ditch cleanout at \$5,073.

Ron Haden, Engineer, and Steve Goins, Assistant to the Engineer, met with the Board to update them on Secondary Road projects.

It was moved by Nicholson and seconded by Jacobs to approve Underground Permit #12-2012 for Lester Schleisman to place a 2" pvc pipe under the road to run a garden hose through to water cattle; being located between Sections 26 and 35, Jackson Township, Ayes all. Motion carried.

Pam Anderson, Director Economic Development, met with the Board to update them on economic development issues.

CALHOUN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2012-4

RAGBRAI

SALES OF FOOD AND OTHER MERCHANDISE

Section 1 – PURPOSE: To control the safety and well being of public during RAGBRAI drive through Calhoun County, Iowa on July 24, 2012.

Section 2-DEFINITIONS: Vendor shall include any person, association, corporation, organization or other entity that sells food, beverages, services, or any merchandise to the public by the way of a temporary stand or distribution area in the unincorporated areas of Calhoun County, Iowa, on July 24, 2012.

Section 3-REQUIREMENTS: The sale of food, beverages, services, or merchandise or the location of a temporary stand for the sale of these things without a permit is hereby declared to be in violation of this ordinance. It shall be a simple misdemeanor for any person to sell or supply food, beverages, services, or merchandise in the un-incorporated areas of Calhoun County, Iowa, on July 24, 2012 without having obtained a vendors permit with the exception set out in Section 5 below.

Each separate sale after the vendor is told of the need for a permit shall be deemed a separate violation of this ordinance and each sale is subject to the maximum fine of \$100 or 30 days in jail for a simple misdemeanor.

Section 4-PERMITS: Permits will be issued by Calhoun County. The applications for permits shall be submitted to the Calhoun County Department of Public Health. Vendor permit fee for non-food is \$25. Food license fees are \$33.

All permit applications shall be submitted by July 14, 2012. The applicable agency shall review all applications to insure that all necessary licenses and paperwork is completed.

Food and beverage vendors must comply with all laws, rules and regulations promulgated by the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals relating to and governing the sale of food from a temporary food establishment.

The application shall be reviewed to ensure that all requirements have been met. A plan of placement shall be developed with the interest of safety and well being of the general public and the RAGBRAI riders in mind and will also take into consideration the request of the vendor.

Once the application is reviewed by the applicable committee or agency, their report and the plan of placement shall be forwarded to the designated employee of Calhoun County who shall review the application and the plan of placement and either authorize the granting of or the denying of the permit. A vendor permit shall be granted if all requirements are met and on the condition that the vendor locate his or her sale stand at a location to be determined in the plan of placement.

The designated employee shall ensure that notice is sent to any vendor whose application is denied or whose requested placement is altered. The vendor is required to locate where the plan of placement and permit places him or her. In the case of a denial of a permit or an objection to the plan of placement, the vendor may appeal to the County Board of Supervisors by written notice of appeal at the Calhoun County Auditor's office within 3 days of the date of the decision by the designated employee of Calhoun County.

Section 5-EXCEPTION: No vendor's permit shall be required for any person to sell or supply food or other merchandise in Calhoun County, Iowa, on July 24, 2012, on his or her previously licensed premises, provided that the person was in possession of a current Iowa Permit for the sale of food or other merchandise or for the consumption on the premises.

Section 6-REPEALER: Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 7-SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 8-EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

Ivan Droessler, Drainage Engineer from I&S Kuehl & Payer and David Wollenzien, Drainage Attorney, met with the Board concerning reclassification of DD#120 East Main, Manson.

It was moved by Jacobs and seconded by Hoag, Sr. to adjourn until 9:00 am on Tuesday, May 1, for their next regular meeting. Ayes all. Motion carried.
