Pam Anderson, Director of Economic Development, updated the Board on a truck stop development on the northwest corner of the junction of Highway 4 and Highway 20. Also present were: Rollin Tiefenthaler; Cindy Tiefenthaler; Tia Tiefenthaler; Kelly Smidt; Roxanne Carish, CEO from REC; and Mike Moran, REC Member Services.

The Board received a telephonic call from Sac County to discuss lowering the warrant rates for the joint drainage districts of Sac and Calhoun County from 6% to 5%.
