It was moved by Nicholson and seconded by Hoag, Sr. to review the claims (checks 37773 through 37934) and were allowed as endorsed. Ayes all. Motion carried.

It was moved by Hoag, Sr. and seconded by Nicholson to approve the Contract for Library Service for Calhoun County for a county appropriation of \$153,484 for FY 14/15 as to a formula as agreed by the libraries. Ayes all. Motion carried.

It was moved by Hoag, Sr. and seconded by Nicholson to authorize the Chairman to sign the termination grant DR-1854-0003 which the original planning grant was to complete a multi-jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan. Ayes all. Motion carried.
